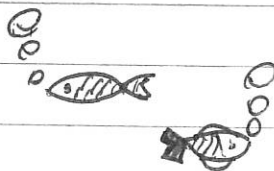

I would love the opportunity to be an animal advocate because I want to make sure the school animals are safe, clean and well taken care of.

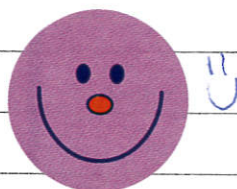
I think that you can trust because I'm experienced with animals from home, I'm sensible and I don't care if animals wee or poo on me as I just want them to have a good life.
