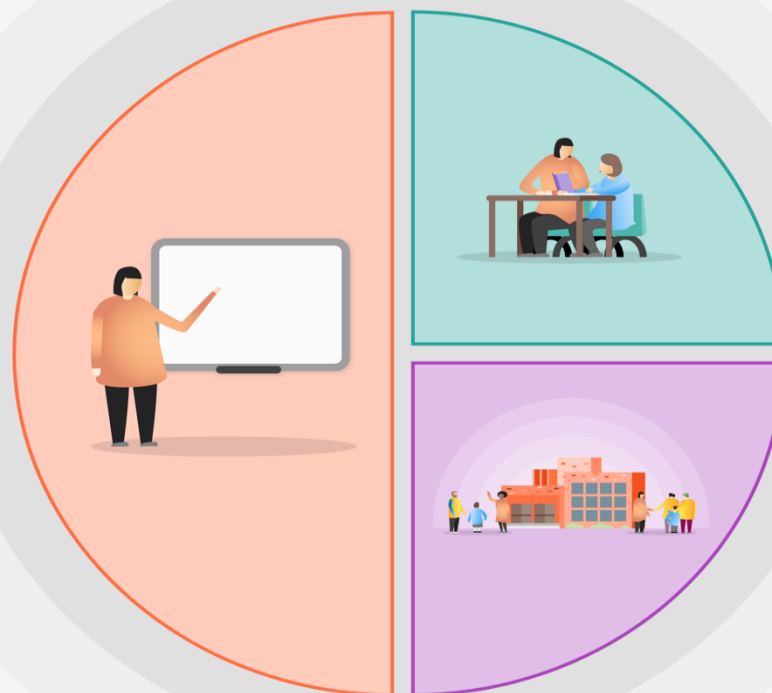


COVID Catch-up premium plan 2022 - William Harding School



1 Teaching

- ▶ Adapted timetables to include well-being, a focus on key skills catch up
- ▶ A broad and balanced subject based curriculum for all
- ▶ Whole class quality first teaching
- ▶ Assessment approach to analysing the gaps and planning astutely to these (MTPs, PMs)
- ▶ High quality resources to support teaching and subject knowledge
- ▶ Focussed Learning Days for engagement & broad and balanced curriculum for all
- ▶ LORIC/Debates for self esteem & sense of self
- ▶ Ensuring pupils are ready to learn with increased FLO support
- ▶ Additional TAs, Cover supervisors and 1 x teacher for support/teaching/boosting
- ▶ AHT teaching of boosters to support outcomes

- ▶ SEND additional support and resources located and put in place
- ▶ Interventions (Provision Maps)
- ▶ Pre-teaching
- ▶ Post teaching
- ▶ Individual Provision maps
- ▶ Online homework
- ▶ Loaned devices

3 Wider strategies

- ▶ 2 additional FLOs, team of 5, in response to need (anxiety/bereavement etc)
- ▶ Increased School Counsellor hours
- ▶ IPSL (Inclusion, Pastoral, safeguarding lead) to lead on an increased Personal development curriculum/offer
- ▶ Increased engagement with agencies
- ▶ Re-engagement programme to support return to school
- ▶ Pastoral Mentor Programme
- ▶ Family room for families in crisis
- ▶ Nurture room for pupils in need of a quiet space and additional support
