

Knowledge Organiser - Combining different fabric shapes (Textiles Year 6)

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Seam	A line where two pieces of fabric are sewn together.
Wadding	Soft, thick material used to line garments. E.g. cotton wool formed into a fleecy layer.
Hem	The edge of a piece of cloth or clothing which has been turned under and sewn.
Fastening	A device that closes or secures something.
Needle	A very fine slender piece of polished metal with a point at one end and a hole or eye for thread at the other, used in sewing.
Thread	A long, thin strand of cotton, nylon or other fibres used in sewing.
Functionality	The quality of being suited to serve a purpose well.
Innovation	The action or process of turning an idea into a product.
Authentic	Undisputed origin and not a copy. Genuine.
Prototype	A first or preliminary version of a device from which other forms are developed.
