
Why Read Write Inc?

- Speak articulately




- For all children to have a love of reading, books and stories

Complex Speed Sounds chart

- 44 sounds
- Over 150+ graphemes
- In Year 1 the children recap the Set 1 sounds and begin to learn the Set 2 sounds. By the end of the year the aim is for them to have learnt Set 1, 2 and 3 sounds.

How it works

The children are sorted in to groups according to ability. This allows us to tailor each lesson to the children in that group and support their specific needs.

The lesson structure involves;

- Learn a new sound every day
- Review learnt sounds
- ▶ Blend by sight Special friends, Fred talk, read the word.
- Fred in your head.
- Read words by sight speedy reading
- Alien words.
- Segment sounds to spell using Fred Fingers
- Story book words and reading.



The expectation is that all children will be off of the RWI program by the beginning of Year 2.



Fred Fingers

- Say the sounds you need
- Count and show that many fingers
- Pinch the sounds on your Fred Fingers
- Write the words down
- Check it by pointing and swiping to blend
- Use a sound chart to help you check the sounds

Blending sounds



- Check the sounds you need to use are recognised
- Point to and read the sounds.
- Swipe the sounds to blend them to read the word
- Model clearly your thought process

Reading

- The children read different story books depending on the group they are in and their sounds knowledge. These books are designed to support the children with sounds they already know to support their reading.
- ► This is now also supported by our new reading approach A letter went out on Friday explaining how to access this and how it works. There will also be more information about this from your class teacher when you go into the classrooms for come and read shortly.







How can you help your child at home?

- Practise the speed sounds at home.
- Read stories regularly with your child.
 - range of books stories and information
 - reading record book
- Practise blending at home using set 1/2 initially and moving towards set 3 when the children are ready.
- ▶ If you want to buy a set of sound cards they are available for approx. £5 on Amazon: Read Write Inc home flashcards.

RWI virtual classroom


- RWI use a program called Virtual Classroom. This allows the children to access virtual RWI lessons.
- We are able to share this resource with you at home so that the children can also practice their sounds at home. It is an excellent resource and will be able to provide guidance and see for yourselves what the children do in school.
- A letter will be sent home about how to access the Virtual Classroom.

- Set aside 10 minutes to watch a film with your child each day.
- Find a quiet space for your child to watch the film on a laptop or tablet.
- Praise your child as they join in with the lesson
 make it fun!

Phonics Screening Check

The phonics screening check will happen the week commencing the 10th June 2024.


It is a word-reading test where the children will read 40 words.

There is a pass mark of approximately 32, if children do not achieve this then they complete it again in Year 2.

It takes between 2 - 5 minutes.

Half of the words are real words and half of them are nonsense (alien) words. These have a picture of an alien next to them.

There will be more information about the phonics screening check in the future.
