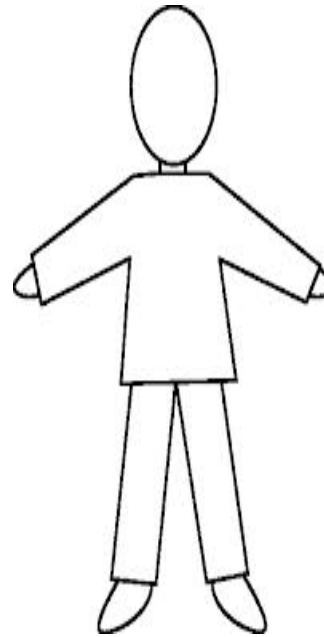


Pupil Premium Provision Map

The pupil premium is additional monies given to schools to support pupils who are considered 'disadvantaged.' The chosen measure for this is the entitlement of Free School Meals within the past 6 years. The current funding is £1,300 per pupil

Supporting the whole child Academically



Quality first teaching – Whole School

Overview: To give all pupils the opportunity to have high quality teaching

Aim/Outcome:

- All pupils learn well and benefit from the best teaching

CDP – Staff meetings

Overview: Regular staff training on high quality teaching and learning for all including PP

Aim/Outcome:

- To share good practice
- To develop staff skills in teaching all pupils especially PP
- To promote all pupils especially PP across the whole school

Interventions – Whole School

Overview: To give all pupils the opportunity to have additional support if they have not fully understood the learning that has taken place.

Aim/Outcome:

- To narrow the gap in progress and attainment of all PP children
- To reduce any COVID gap

Resources – Whole school

Overview: To provide up to date resources to support the development of all pupils especially PP children.

Aim/Outcome:

- To narrow the gap in progress and attainment of all PP children
- To give PP children learning opportunities that they may not have access to e.g. iPads

Additional teacher/teaching assistants

Overview: To ensure that all PP children are receiving Quality First Teaching and provide opportunities to close the gap.

Aim/Outcome:

- To improve confidence and self esteem
