Parents will now be able to book the timings of the session to suit their needs and will only pay for the length of session they want to have. In addition, parents will be able to book ad hoc sessions and can book sessions up to the night before. • We have reviewed our trips for 2023-24 to ensure that they cover a range of topics. • We will continue to look at offering a wide range of after school clubs.
