Key Vocabulary	Definition
Climate	The weather conditions in an area over a long period of time.
Temperate Climate	A climate where the conditions do not get extremely hot or extremely cold.
Trade	Buying and selling things, for example food, machines, books
Import	Buying things from other countries.
Export	Selling things to other countries.
Agriculture	The farming of plants and/or animals.
The Alps	A large mountain range located in Western Europe.
Balkans	South of the Danube are the Balkan countries, along the Balkan Peninsula. These include Croatia, Albania, Bulgaria.
Baltic Countries	Countries located on the Baltic Sea Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia. This term sometimes includes Poland.
Steppe	Grassland plains without trees apart from those near rivers and lakes.
